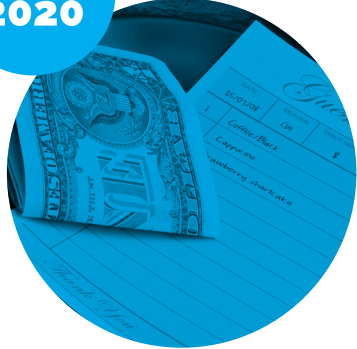

# COVID-19 Restaurant Impact 2020 Snapshot

**\$12.9 billion**

Estimated sales in the state's restaurants in 2019

**310,100**

Restaurant and foodservice jobs in the state in 2020 or

**11** % of employment in the state

**\$775 million**

restaurant sales lost in April due to COVID-19 outbreak

**171,000**

employees laid off or furloughed since COVID-19 outbreak

**83**

% restaurant operators have laid off or furloughed employees

**65**

% restaurant operators say it is unlikely that their restaurant will be profitable within the next 6 months

**52**

% of operators say their total operational costs are higher than they were prior to the COVID-19 outbreak

**53**

% of operators say it is unlikely their restaurant will still be in business in 6 months without an additional relief package from the federal government

**56**

% of operators expect their staffing levels to decline during the next 3 months

**38**

% of operators say they are considering temporarily closing their restaurant until the COVID-19 pandemic passes
